What's Cooking: Tempt your taste buds with this introduction to basic baking and cooking techniques.

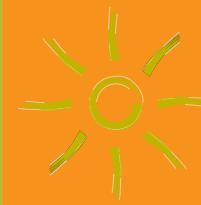
Animal Kingdom: Explore the wonderful and fascinating world of all creatures great and small.
