PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

Lesley Ellis "Young Adventurers" is a summer
 program for Preschool, Prekindergarten, and
 (entering) Kindergarten explorers.

Is your favorite outfit your bathing suit? Then spend
 part of your summer with Lesley Ellis' unique early
 childhood summer program.

Each week we enjoy a field trip--to the zoo, a pottery
 studio, or a science museum. We also explore local
 sprinkler parks and playgrounds. The program
 features a series of special visitors and each day we
 play on the playground or walk
 to a local park.

Each session is limited to 25 campers and is led by
 two experienced early childhood teachers and a
 teaching assistant. Choose a 3-day, 4-day or 5-day
 schedule. Each week means a new session with new
 adventures. The day runs from 8:00 am until 4:00
 pm--drop-off is between 8:00 and 9:00; parents may
 pick up any time after 1:00. There are ten one-week
 sessions over the course of the summer.
