LESLEY ELLIS AFTERSCHOOL INFORMATION

Each day in afterschool students will participate in an activity. In addition, there is a homework/quiet reading time and an opportunity to play outside. Snack is not provided.

- Afterschool classes are offered in five, 2-month sessions. Sessions are 5-8 weeks long and meet weekly.
- Enrollment is on a first come-first served basis.
- If enrollment is low we will combine activities.

- When we can we will accommodate drop-ins. Please fill out an Extended Hours form in the office. Some activities are not open to children enrolled on a drop-in basis.
- Vacation Program is available on Early Release days and various non-school days.
- Pick-up time is at 5:30. Parents arriving after 5:30 will be assessed a late fee.
