LES Clubhouse Middle School Grades 5 - 8

LES Clubhouse is a great way to come together and spend the afternoon with friends. These activities are specifically designed for middle school students as an extension of their day and are included in tuition. They are scheduled in conjunction with athletics and middle school theater schedules. All activities are Monday through Thursday, 3:15-4:30.

In addition to LES Clubhouse, Ski Club has become a tradition at LES with students from K-grade 8 coming together every Thursday afternoon during ski season to take lessons and ski with their friends. There is a fee for this activity.

For an additional cost, students can enroll in a Supervised Study on Friday afternoons. Should middle school students need to remain at school after any Afterschool Program beyond 4:30, we are offering a comfortable place in the LES foyer to complete their assignments.

Descriptions of Middle School Activities

Explorations in Mathematics:

"There is geometry in the humming of the strings, there is music in the spacing of the spheres." - Pythagoras

Following last year's "Mathematics and Projection" and "Mathematics and the Greeks," we continue this fall with an exploration of "Mathematics and Music." Rhythm, scales, intervals, pitch, harmonies - the creations of composers and sounds made by musicians are all connected to mathematics. We'll explore what mathematics and music have in common, and how mathematics is used to create the music we enjoy. We will conclude the term with each student creating and sharing an autobiography in music. All middle school students are welcome - no particular music knowledge or experience necessary.
