

## Session 1

### SEPTEMBER - OCTOBER

**Tuesday - Down by the Pond:** Teachers will introduce the environment and habitat of pond animals and take a walking trip to Spy Pond to see pond animals!

**Wednesday - Rainy Days:** Even if the sun is shining, make wet, rainy crafts.

**Thursday - Knucklebones:** An exciting program to enhance gross motor skills, athletic fundamentals, physical exercise, creative movement, and fun!

**Friday - Tell Me a Story:** Create and tell stories using crafts, games, and songs.

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## Session 2

### NOVEMBER - DECEMBER

**Monday - Dinosaurs:** Become a paleontologist and discover the fun of dinosaurs. Rawr!!!

**Tuesday - Fun with Fabric:** Print, draw, and paint on fabric using a variety of materials.

**Wednesday - Teddy Bears' Picnic:** What's more fun than spending the afternoon at school with your favorite stuffie? Come sing songs, play games and make crafts.

**Thursday - Knucklebones:** An exciting program to enhance gross motor skills, athletic fundamentals, physical exercise, creative movement, and fun!

**Friday - Songs and Games:** Get our bodies moving with songs and games both old and new.

## Session 3

### JANUARY - FEBRUARY

**Monday - Puppets:** Learn the art of puppet-making by using socks, brown bags and many other creative items.

**Tuesday - Yarn and String:** Get tangled up in some fun projects with yarn and string.

**Wednesday - Fairies, Princes and Frogs:** From magic castles to dragons' caves, explore the wonder of fairytales.

**Thursday - Knucklebones:** An exciting program to enhance gross motor skills, athletic fundamentals, physical exercise, creative movement, and fun!

**Friday - Mad Science:** Perform fun experiments to discover the principle elements of science.

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## Session 4

### MARCH - APRIL

**Monday - Cars and Trucks:** Get out on the road with cars and trucks.

**Tuesday - Fruits and Veggies:** Have fun learning about eating healthy and how fruit and vegetables grow.

**Wednesday - Ant Adventures:** Hey, little ant! What are you doing down there? Why are you always so busy? Join us on an adventure learning all about our tiny friends.

**Thursday - Knucklebones:** An exciting program to enhance gross motor skills, athletic fundamentals, physical exercise, creative movement, and fun!

**Friday - Author, Author:** We will chose our favorite author each day and create a fun craft inspired by their books.

## Session 5 MAY - JUNE

**Monday - Bugs and Butterflies:** From the creepy and crawly to the bright and beautiful, each day will present a new project featuring insects.

**Tuesday - Blooming Together:** Use all the colors of the rainbow to create marvelous bouquets as you explore the world of plants and flowers.

**Wednesday - Down on the Farm:** From cows and chickens to tractors and barns, there is no telling what we will find down on the farm!

**Thursday - Knucklebones:** An exciting program to enhance gross motor skills, athletic fundamentals, physical exercise, creative movement, and fun!

**Friday - What's Up?:** Explore kites, chimes, birds and other things that float and move in the wind.



## Frequently Asked Questions

### How does a session work?

Each session begins on the first of the month and continues until the last day. For example, Session 1 ends on Thursday, October 31. Session 2 then begins immediately on Friday, November 1.

### What are the hours of Clubhouse?

Clubhouse begins at 3:15 and ends at 5:30. Parents are welcome to pick up their child at any time. A late fee will be assessed for children picked up after 5:30.

### How do I register my child?

Parents may enroll in Clubhouse by going to our website [www.lesleyellis.org](http://www.lesleyellis.org) and click on Auxiliary Programs. Parents may enroll their child on a session-by-session basis or for the full school year.

### What if something unexpectedly comes up?

If you unexpectedly need care during the afternoon you can enroll in Extended Hours.
